The mission of the Delaware Ovarian Cancer Foundation is to increase awareness and education about ovarian cancer among women and healthcare professionals in Delaware and the surrounding vicinity. The Foundation is committed to research and provides support for women affected by ovarian cancer.

Ovarian Cancer Facts and Figures

In 2008, the American Cancer Society estimated that more than 21,600 new cases of ovarian cancer were diagnosed, resulting in over 15,500 deaths from the disease. About 1 in 57 women develop ovarian cancer, the deadliest of the gynecologic cancers.

Because there is no reliable diagnostic screening for ovarian cancer, it often goes undetected or is misdiagnosed until it has advanced to the later stages. Unfortunately, more than 75% of women who are diagnosed in the later stages where the 5-year survival rate is very low. Only 19% of cases are diagnosed early, resulting in an overall survival rate of less than 50%. Between 70-90% of all women who survive ovarian cancer eventually will have a recurrence of the disease.

** A Pap Test does not detect ovarian cancer! **

Ovarian cancer does not discriminate, affecting females of any age and ethnic background. The lack of public awareness and education about ovarian cancer is a critical health issue.

Risk Factors

September is National Ovarian Cancer Awareness Month

Even in its early stages, ovarian cancer has symptoms. Once thought to be a "silent disease", research indicates that 95% of women with ovarian cancer have vague but persistent symptoms. Although symptoms of ovarian cancer are often not acute or intense (particularly in the early stages), they are NOT silent. The following symptoms are likely to occur in women with ovarian cancers.

KNOW THE SIGNS OF OVARIAN CANCER and CHECK THEM OUT!

- Bloating
- Pelvic or abdominal pain
- Difficulty eating or feeling full quickly
- Urinary symptoms (frequency or urgency)

Other symptoms of ovarian cancer may include:

- Extreme fatigue
- Gas, Indigestion, heartburn or upset stomach
- Back pain
- Change in bowel habits (constipation, diarrhea)
- Weight gain or weight weight loss
- Menstrual irregularities
- Pain during intercourse

These symptoms may also be indicative of other conditions; however, if any symptoms persist for more than 2 weeks, consult your doctor *immediately!*

Risk Factors

- Genetic predisposition
- Personal or family history of breast, ovarian or Colon cancer
- Increasing age
- Undesired infertility
